# Aera Energy Matching Gifts Program

Each calendar year Aera Energy LLC will match up to \$1,000 per year in donations by eligible employees to qualifying schools and educational institutions. Aera Energy will grant a 2:1 match, which will be applied to gifts that support the primary educational mission of the institution.

#### Eligible Participants

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All regular and limited benefit employees of Aera Energy Services Company (full time and part time) are eligible for the Aera Energy Matching Gifts Program. Individuals classified as independent contractors, leased employees and employees hired for temporary periods under special programs - such as summer interns - are ineligible for the program.

#### Eligible Organizations

Public and private K-12 schools and higher education institutions are eligible. These include primary and secondary schools; two-year and four-year colleges and universities; graduate and professional schools; and technical institutes.

In addition, the American Indian College Fund, the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities, and the United Negro College Fund are eligible for the program. No other funds or federations are eligible.

The school or institution must be located in the United States or one of its possessions and accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting body. It must be recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt and designated a public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code or as an instrumentality of a federal, state or local government as provided by Section 170(c)(1) of the Code.

#### Eligible Gifts

- The donation or gift must support the primary educational mission of the school or institution
- It must be a tax deductible donation from an employee's personal funds that has been paid - and not simply pledged to an approved organization.
- The gift must be made directly to the school, college, or university. The donation should be made to the parent institution, not to a sub-unit of the institution. However, the donor may designate a specific purpose for which the gift is to be used. The company match will go to the specific purpose designated by the donor, which may include a particular subunit such as a department, academic program, or scholarship fund.
- A donation may be made to the general-purpose foundation established by some institutions, but a donation may not be made to any other separately incorporated group or organization acting as a conduit of funds to the institution.
- The minimum gift eligible for matching is \$50.
- The maximum amount matched per donor per calendar year is \$1000. If an employee makes several contributions, gifts will be matched in the order received, up to the maximum annual donor limit for the calendar year.
- The donor's limit is based on the date of the gift.
- Gifts may be in the form of check, credit card, or marketable securities with a quoted market value.
- Donors may be asked to provide proof of a contribution in the form of a cancelled check, bank statement, credit card statement, or a transfer of stock certificate.
- Gifts of securities are valued based on the average of the high and low on the date of the gift. No other form of personal or real property will be matched.

#### Ineligible Gifts

The following gifts are not eligible for a company match:

- Gifts made by or through Community Trusts or similar organizations, including Charitable Remainder Trusts, Donor Advised Funds, or Family Foundations
- Payments for which the donor, a family member, or other individuals designated by the donor receive a direct benefit.
   Examples include payments for services, tuition, books, or other student fees; gifts to fulfill pledges, tithes, or other religious-related financial commitments or legal obligations; publication subscription fees; membership dues; ticket purchases; insurance premiums; bequests
- Gifts to ineligible organizations. Examples include gifts to alumni associations; athletic associations; booster clubs, parent-teacher associations or organizations; contributions to individuals, fraternities or sororities; gifts given to or through a third party.
- Gifts for non scholastic purposes, i.e. dinners, events, athletics, athletic scholarships, marching band, stadium construction or maintenance.
- Gifts for trips, i.e. senior trips, band trips, attendance at conferences.
- Gifts in the form of premiums on insurance under which the institution is the beneficiary.
- Gifts of real or personal property
- Cumulative gifts from several individuals reported as one contribution

## How Does the Program Work?

Employees may request matching gifts online at http://www.easymatch.com/aeraenergy or by submitting this paper form, which is processed as follows:

#### Employee Instructions

The employee completes Part 1 of the form and mails the completed form and any other necessary documentation to the recipient organization.

#### Organization Instructions

The recipient organization completes Part 2 of the form and mails the completed form to the Aera Energy Matching Gifts Program at P.O. Box 2157, Princeton, NJ 08543-2157.

### Processing Timetable

Eligible requests are processed quarterly. Matching gifts are distributed once each quarter when received by the following cut-off dates:

Received By:	3/31	6/30	9/30	12/31	

Distributed By: 4/30 7/31 10/31 1/31

Matching Gifts must be requested within six months of the gift date. Requests received after that time will not be honored. Receipt of the gift will be verified by the organization.
