i ne Program	The Matching Gift program is an educational and cultural philanthropy program designed to match the personal financial contributions of U.S. employees and retirees to eligible educational institutions. The program is effective starting August 1, 2005. Matching contributions will be processed semiannually in the first and third quarter of each year beginning in 2006.						
Eligible Participants	 Individuals classified as regular, full-time or less-than-full-time status U.S. employees of Dow AgroSciences LLC (DAS) or Agrigenetics, Inc. d/b/a Mycogen Seeds (Mycogen) and their respective wholly owned subsidiaries Retired U.S. employees receiving a service or disability pension from the company 						
	The individual need not have attended the educational institution to which he or she contributes.						
Eligible U.S. Institutions	 Educational Institutions Four-year institutions accredited by one of the six nationally-recognized regional accrediting commissions recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. Two-year colleges in communities serving DAS or Mycogen employees. Public television and radio stations associated with an approved 4-year or 2-year institution meeting the above criteria. United Negro College Fund, American Indian College Fund and the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities. Non-profit U.S. Associations for foreign institutions. Accredited public and private primary and secondary schools offering a high school curriculum and granting a diploma upon satisfactory completion of such program. State and national 4-H and FFA organizations. If a gift is to an educational institution, only gifts that support the primary educational objectives of the institution will be matched. Gifts earmarked for non-educational purposes (e.g. the athletic department) will not be eligible for matching Cultural Institutions 						
	 Primary purpose must be cultural, e.g., museums, arts councils, cultural centers, botanical or zoological societies, public broadcasting systems, libraries, symphony orchestras, historical associations, performing arts companies. Must be located within the U.S. and recognized under IRS Code Section 501(c)(3). 						
Gift Amount	 ?? The minimum contribution by a single individual must be \$250. ?? Match 1:1 - The Dow Chemical Company Foundation will match dollar-for-dollar each individual's contributions to approved U.S. based colleges, universities, schools and qualifying cultural organizations up to \$5,000 per institution. ?? Each eligible participant can have up to \$10,000 in qualifying contributions matched annually. ?? The Dow Chemical Company Foundation's match to any individual organization or institution is capped at \$100,000 annually. 						
Ineligible Gifts	 Contributions made by spouse or made jointly with a spouse or other individual. Non-cash contributions (other than publicly-traded securities) such as real or personal property, works of art, donated labor. Gifts intended to fulfill a person's pledges, tithes or other church/school-related financial commitments. Gifts to capital campaigns or building funds or multi-year pledges. Gifts to private or community foundations. Gifts to conservation, environmental or ecological organizations. Gifts to fraternities, sororities, educational associations and campus organizations. Gifts to educational institutions for non-scholastic programs, such as athletics or stadium construction and scholarship funds for athletics. Payments that cover tuition, books, student fees, subscriptions, insurance premiums, tickets or other considerations. Gifts to daycare centers, preschools or kindergartens. Gifts that return some significant benefit to the donor such as tuition, admission fees, tickets, subscription fee for publications, fund-raising dinners or events, tickets for athletic cultural or other events, auction items, books, insurance premiums and policies or other considerations. 						

?? Bequests, pledges, tuition payments or payments in lieu of tuition or other student fees.

- ?? Gifts for non-scholastic programs such as athletic activities, scholarships and facilities or other extracurricular activities.
- ?? Community fundraisers such as walk-a-thons, runs and cycling events that raise money by soliciting sponsors.
- ?? Gifts that designate specific individuals/recipients, such as scholarships or financial aid.
- ?? Gifts matched by other companies or subsidiaries of The Dow Chemical Company or DAS or Mycogen will not be matched.
- ?? Gifts made more than six months prior to the Company's receipt of the completed Matching Gifts Form from educational or cultural organization.

Contributions Your contribution must be a personal gift, and it must be paid, not merely pledged, directly to an approved institution in cash or publicly traded securities. The basis for matching securities is the value at time of transfer.

Administrative conditions The Dow Chemical Company Foundation and DAS and Mycogen reserve the right to suspend, change, or terminate this program at any time. The interpretation, application, and administration will be determined solely by The Dow Chemical Company Foundation, whose decision will be final.
