

Enova International Guidelines

Eligible Organizations:

To be eligible for matching gifts, organizations must be located in the United States and recognized as a tax-exempt charity by the Internal Revenue Service under Section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

The following organizations or categories of service are not eligible for matching donations through this program:

- **Religious organizations** - for example, churches, universities and synagogues, and any organization whose purpose is to promote or to discourage the observance or proselytization of religious beliefs. Secular community service programs such as soup kitchens, shelters for the homeless, and job banks are eligible, even when sponsored by religious groups, as long as they do not have a religious focus.
- **Athletics** - all programs whose primary focus is in support of any athletic activity, for example, youth or adult athletic programs, booster clubs, scholarships, and community leagues
- **Family foundations**
- **Schools and universities**
- **Gifts that benefit a particular student or group of students** - such as booster clubs, trips, choirs, bands, tours, and internships
- **Political organizations** and activities
- **Fraternal organizations**
- **Gifts that result in an employee or a family member receiving a benefit** - for example, dinner, raffle, sporting event tickets, parking privileges, club dues, and any other direct services
- **Gifts made into Donor Advised Funds** - The distribution made from those funds in the employee's name to qualified organizations are eligible for matching
- **Deferred gifts** - for example, annuities and charitable remainder trusts, bequests, and insurance premiums that name the organization as the beneficiary
- **Tuition** fees, loan repayments, and payments in lieu of tuition
- **A pledge for payment not yet made**
- **Pooled gifts** - gifts made jointly by several individuals
