



Dollars for Doers

The Fannie Mae Foundation wants to reward your volunteer efforts through our Dollars for Doers program. All that's required is that you volunteer a minimum of 25 hours with a qualified organization, and the Foundation will complement your volunteer time with a grant to that organization. It's that simple. By volunteering, you help to support and improve the quality of life in your community. Dollars for Doers is a component of the WAVE volunteer program that matches the interests, talents, and skills of Fannie Mae and Fannie Mae Foundation volunteers with the needs of community agencies.

Who is Eligible

- All full-time employees and part-time employees with at least 20 hours per week who have been with Fannie Mae or the Fannie Mae Foundation for six months are eligible.
- Employees who have completed the following number of volunteer service hours with a nonprofit organization:
 - 25 hours (eligible for a \$100 grant)
 - 50 hours (eligible for a \$250 grant)
 - 100 hours (eligible for a \$500 grant)

Note: Only hours volunteered after an employee is eligible to participate in the program may be counted. While each employee may only apply for one grant per calendar year, more than one employee may request grant funds for the same organization.

What Organizations are Eligible

- Any organization recognized as a 501(c)(3) public charity by the Internal Revenue Service. You may verify an organization's IRS status through the Guidestar Web site at www.guidestar.org.

The Foundation cannot make grants for

- International purposes. Fannie Mae Foundation is funded solely by Fannie Mae. As Fannie Mae does most of its business in the U.S., the directors of the Foundation have chosen to make all of our grants, including Dollars for Doers grants, within the U.S.
- Religious or other sectarian purposes. Gifts to sectarian organizations may be matched if the organization uses the funds primarily to benefit people outside of its own membership.

How Does The Program Work?

The Fannie Mae Foundation will provide grant funds directly to the recipient nonprofit organization. Grant applications may be sent in at any time during the year, but must be received by March 31 to be eligible for the previous calendar year. Volunteer hours do not carry over from year to year.
