DOLLARS FOR DOERS PROGRAM

GUIDELINES

Program Description:

The Dollars For Doers Program is one of a few programs nationwide that rewards local community volunteerism. The Land O'Lakes Foundation gives financial grants to eligible nonprofit organizations based on the amount of time a volunteer gives to the organization. Through Dollars for Doers, the organization benefits twice: once from the volunteer's contribution of time and again from a Land O'Lakes Foundation financial contribution.

Dollars for Doers grants are awarded for many types of volunteer activities including teaching reading for literacy, working as a volunteer firefighter, delivering meals to seniors, and many activities that build and strengthen communities.

Program Guidelines:

- Volunteer hours add up to dollars for the organization to which time is donated. The volunteer may apply for grant funds for the nonprofit organization after completing the following number of volunteer hours at one organization:
 - \$100 for 16 hours of service
 - \$250 for 50 hours of service
 - \$500 for 100 hours of service
- Hours accumulate during the calendar year from January 1 to December 31, and can't be carried over from year to year. Volunteers who are newly hired can start accumulating hours right away.
- Volunteers can apply for a grant anytime during the year, but the application deadline is December 15.
- Volunteers can receive one grant per year. More than one employee can apply for grant funds for the same organization.
- Dollars for Doers grants are paid on a quarterly basis. Employees will be notified when the match is completed.
- Land O'Lakes Foundation reserves the right to change or withdraw this program without notice. The interpretations and administration of the provisions of the program are determined by the Foundation.

Eligibility:

Full-time, part-time and retired employees of Land O'Lakes, Inc. are eligible to apply.

Eligible volunteer organizations must be:

- A nonprofit agency
- Certified for tax-exempt status under the Internal Revenue Service Code 501(c)(3)

Ineligible organizations include:

• Lobbying, political, religious, fraternal, veteran and labor organizations

Application Procedure:

Participating volunteers must complete Part 1 of the application and send the entire application to the nonprofit organization. The recipient organization must complete Part 2 and forward the completed application with a copy of the 501(c)(3) letter to the Foundation at the address below.

Note: If a volunteer's service is coordinated through one of the above types of organizations, but clearly benefits an eligible nonprofit agency, that agency may receive a grant. **For example**, if your volunteer service for a food shelf has been organized by a church, the food shelf is eligible to receive a grant.
