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U.S. Matching Gift Program

To encourage and support the generosity of employees, Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals is proud to offer the Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals Matching Gift Program. Through this program, an employee may request a matching gift from the company after they have given a personal donation to an eligible charitable organization.

Eligibility: All active U.S. full-time and part-time, non-union employees of Mallinckrodt Pharmaceuticals, and members of the Board of Directors, are eligible to participate in the Matching Gift Program. Spouses and surviving spouses of eligible employees are not eligible.

Matching Limits: A minimum donation of \$25 is required to be eligible for a match. The company will match up to \$2,500 per fiscal year, per individual. Funds are limited; matches are granted on a first-come, first-serve basis until the annual budget is met.

Eligible Recipients: Eligible 501(c)(3) organizations include, but are not limited to: colleges and universities, private and public elementary and secondary schools, arts and culture organizations, health and human services agencies, civic organizations and environmental organizations.

Matching Rates:

100% match for eligible health and human services organizations

50% match for eligible organizations in all other categories

Deadline: Match requests must be submitted within three (3) months of the donation to be processed.

Types of Gifts Not Eligible for a Match:

- Gifts made by or through Community Trusts or similar organizations, including Charitable Remainder Trusts, Donor Advised Funds, or Family Foundations.
- Gifts or payments to sectarian institutions: churches, mosques, synagogues or temples; social service programs such as a food pantry or homeless shelter provided by a sectarian institution must have their own established federally recognized tax-exempt identification to be considered.
- Gifts made to organizations that discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, gender, religion, age, national origin or sexual orientation.
- Gifts made in lieu of tuition payment for services
- Subscription, membership or any other fees for which benefits are received.
- Dues to alumni(ae) or similar groups
- Gifts or payments for primarily political or religious purposes
- Insurance premiums
- Bequests or life income trust arrangements
- Gifts of real or personal property
- Cumulative gifts from several individuals reported as one contribution.
