Dollars for Doers Grants

Employee Eligibility

Regular full-time or part-time employees of National Semiconductor Corporation and its wholly-owned subsidiaries are eligible to participate. Contractors, interns, co-ops or temporary employees are not eligible. At this time, the program is only available to U.S.-based employees.

You must volunteer a minimum average of 4 hours per month for the recipient organization. The volunteer service must be ongoing in nature.

Eligible Organizations

Nonprofit charitable organizations, and accredited and degree-granting private or public education institutions are eligible to receive a Dollars for Doers Grant.

Eligible Organizations must be located in the United States or one of its possessions and be recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt and designated a public charity under Section 501(c)(3) of the code or as an instrumentality of a federal, state or local government as provided by Section 170(c)(1) of the Code.

Ineligible Organizations:

- Religious Organizations (except for ongoing, independently run programs affiliated with religious organizations if the gift is restricted to a nonsectarian project that provides social services to the community at large).
- Non-accredited K-12 schools, colleges or universities.
- Political organizations.
- Organizations that promote a hobby.
- Membership-based organizations (clubs, fraternal groups or professional associations).
- Organizations in which fees are reduced in return for volunteer service (co-op schools).
- Organizations that discriminate on the basis of age, disability, religion, ethnic origin or gender.
- Organizations whose indirect or direct actions negatively impact the company (as determined by National's management).

Available Grants

You may apply for \$500 Dollars For Doers grants for the organizations or schools in which you volunteer.

You can apply for one Dollars for Doers Grant each fiscal year for each eligible organization or educational institution.

Organizations can receive up to a total of \$2500 in Dollars for Doers Grants within a fiscal year.

The interpretation, application and administration of the Dollars for Doers Grant Program will be determined by National Semiconductor whose decision will be final. National may at any time amend, suspend or discontinue the Dollars for Doers Grant Program.
