

PPG Industries Foundation Matching Gifts Program

The PPG Industries Foundation Matching Gifts Program provides an incentive for personal giving by U. S. employees and directors of PPG Industries by matching their contributions to eligible institutions in the United States.

The contributions may be made personally or through the participant's charitable fund. An employee must be in the active regular employment of PPG Industries or its wholly-owned subsidiaries at the time of the contribution. Surviving spouses may make contributions within one year of the death of an employee or director.

The program is governed by the following conditions:

- The minimum contribution that will be matched by the Foundation shall be \$25.00.
- The Foundation will match an individual's contribution up to a total of \$10,000 per year; *(Acknowledgment of matching gifts will be made to each participant in the first quarter of the year following the match.)*
- An eligible contribution is defined as a personal gift actually paid to an organization in cash or securities having a quoted market value. The gift may be from the eligible participant or from the participant's charitable fund. It cannot be a pledge. A confirmation of the gift must be returned to the Foundation by the organization in order to be considered eligible for the Matching Gifts Program.
- The Foundation does not match payments made for services, tuition, athletics, subscriptions, insurance premiums, or any type of payment not made as a direct contribution.
- Recipients must be organized and located within the United States or its possessions, and be recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as organizations to which deductible charitable contributions may be made and as public charities under Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code. Note, however, that supporting organizations classified under 509(a)(3) of the Code (e.g. many foundations and alumni associations) are not eligible recipients.
- **Colleges or universities** must be listed in the Higher Education Directory of the U.S. Office of Education. **Private secondary schools** must be listed in the Handbook of Private Schools, Porter Sargent Publishers, Inc. and a substantial majority of their graduates must enroll in college. Gifts to university/college pooled-income funds are matchable, subject to rules established by the Foundation. Gifts to universities and private secondary schools may be designated for individual academic departments or scholarship funds only. Supporting organizations of colleges or universities (eg. foundations, alumni funds) are not eligible.

- Eligible **cultural institutions** include museums of history, arts, or sciences; libraries; historical, botanical, or zoological societies; performing arts organizations - music, theater, opera, dance; and public broadcasting provided such organizations are open to and operated for the benefit of the general public. Supporting organizations of such entities (e.g. foundations, alumni associations) are not eligible.
- Eligible **special education organizations** serving exceptional children and listed in the Directory for Exceptional Children, Porter Sargent Publishers Inc.
- The **American Red Cross** within 90 days following any declared national or international disaster. The Foundation match will go to the Disaster Relief Fund or the International Response Fund at the National American Red Cross in Washington, D.C.
- In conjunction with PPG Environmental Health & Safety **Wellness Initiatives** specifically identified national health organizations will be eligible for matching for a 60 day period in concurrence with certain identified health education/awareness campaigns.
- Gifts made via Charitable Remainder Trusts or Charitable Gift Annuities will be matched at the value determined by applicable IRS guidelines.
- PPG Industries Foundation shall be entitled to suspend, change, revoke or terminate this program at any time with respect to contributions made thereafter. It may request supporting donor documentation where necessary.
- Questions of interpretation, application or administration of the provisions of the Matching Gifts Program shall be decided by the Foundation's Screening Committee. Its decisions shall be final.

Employees and Directors of PPG Industries:

- Complete Part A. Note minimum and maximum limitations. Use a separate form for each gift made to an eligible organization.
- Mail entire form with contribution to the Chief Financial Officer of the organization.
