

Southern Nuclear Educational Matching Gifts Program Application

The strength and vitality of higher education in America needs the financial support of individuals and the business community. Southern Nuclear has a strong commitment to higher education, and matching gifts are an important part of this overall program.

The purpose of the Educational Matching Gifts Program is to encourage employees and retirees of Southern Nuclear to join the Company in its financial support of institutions of higher education.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Regular, full-time and regular, part-time employees scheduled to work 1,000 hours each year at Southern Nuclear
- Retired employees receiving a pension from the company
- Members and retired members of the Southern Nuclear Board of Directors

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS

Regionally or professionally accredited, degree granting, four year colleges/universities and graduate/professional schools recognized by the Internal Revenue Service as tax-exempt and located within the United States. Alumni Funds/Foundations/Associations which are tax-exempt and that will certify that gifts will be used strictly to contribute toward the achievement of the institution's educational objectives are also eligible.

WHAT CONTRIBUTIONS ARE ELIGIBLE?

- Must be a donation, from the donor's personal funds, which has been paid, and pledged, directly to an approved organization.
- The minimum gift eligible for matching is \$25. For installment gifts, each match request must be submitted separately and meet the \$25 minimum gift requirement.
- The maximum amount matched per donor per calendar year is \$5,000. If the donor makes several contributions, gifts will be matched in the order received, up to the maximum annual donor limit for the calendar year.
- The donor's limit is based on the date of the gift.
- Gifts must be in the form of check, credit card or marketable securities with a quoted market value. Gifts of securities are valued based on the average of the high and low on the date of the gift. No other form of personal or real property will be matched.
- You may be asked to provide proof of your contribution in the form of a cancelled check or bank statement.

WHAT IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR MATCHING?

- Gifts to elementary, secondary schools, vocational schools, and junior/community colleges.
- Payments of tuition or student expenses, pledges, tithes, or other church-related financial commitments.
- Dues, gifts, or subscription fees to alumni groups, booster clubs, or similar organizations whose purpose is other than strict contribution to the institution's primary educational objectives
- Gifts for non-scholastic programs, such as athletics (including athletic scholarships and athletic booster clubs) or stadium construction
- Gifts in the form of premiums on insurance under which the institution is named as beneficiary
- Gifts that are made with funds provided in whole or in part to the donor for donation purposed by other individuals, groups or organizations.

HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

Online:

Employees may request matching gifts through a quick, user-friendly, online request process at the Southern Nuclear Educational Matching Gifts Program web site <http://www.easymatch.com/southernnuclear>.

Following receipt of the request, the Southern Nuclear program administrator will contact the organization to verify receipt of the gift.

Paper:

Employees may request matching gifts through a paper-form process as follows:

Employee Instructions

- Employee completes Section 1 of the form.
- Employee mails the completed form and any other necessary documentation to the organization.

Organization Instructions

- The organization completes Section 2 of the form, verifying that the gift was received.
- The form must be signed by an authorized officer of the organization.
- The organization mails the completed form to the Southern Nuclear Educational Matching Gifts Program at P.O. Box 8377, Princeton, NJ 08543-8377.

Eligible requests are processed on the following quarterly schedule.

Processed By:	3/31	6/30	9/30	12/31

Matching Gifts must be requested within six months of the gift date. Requests received after that time will not be honored. Receipt of gift will be verified by the organization.
