

## 2007 Visa Annual Giving Campaign

### Corporate Match Guidelines

For the 2007 Annual Giving Campaign, Visa will match all eligible donations dollar for dollar with no maximum limit.

#### Eligible Organizations

You may contribute to any nonprofit organization recognized by the IRS under Section 501 (c) (3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code. In addition, gifts made to publicly and privately funded schools, colleges and universities will be matched if they are accredited by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or a state department of education.

#### What is not eligible?

- Gifts that support political parties or candidates, political organizations, lobbying groups or individuals
- Gifts that support labor, social and fraternal organizations
- Gifts that support religious organizations, churches, seminaries, theological institutions and Bible colleges
- Pooled funds of more than one employee or an employee group
- Contributions for which the donor receives a direct-personal benefit such as goods and services, gifts, or advantages of membership
- Gifts from other family members
- Payments that cover the cost of services, tuition, loans, books, or student fees
- Dues and subscriptions

Visa may suspend, amend or discontinue the program at any time without advance notice and reserves the right to determine whether a matching gift shall be made based on eligibility. If a matching gift is at any time found to have been generated by an ineligible person or organization, Visa will expect return of the matching gift. A matching gift from Visa does not necessarily constitute an endorsement by Visa.
