#### THE WARBURG PINCUS FOUNDATION MATCHING GIFT PROGRAM

#### **PURPOSE**

The Warburg Pincus Foundation (the "Foundation"), deeply committed to the support of education, has instituted The Warburg Pincus Foundation Matching Gift Program (the "Program") to encourage all employees of the Warburg Pincus LLC and its subsidiaries (the "Company") in the voluntary support of education. The Program will match any eligible gift made by an individual to an approved donee between July 1, 2006 and June 30, 2007 ("eligible period"), subject to the following guidelines:

#### **ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS**

All employees of the Company.

# **ELIGIBLE DONEES**

Non-profit entities organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes located in the United States and recognized by the Internal Revenue Services as tax-exempt. Determination of a donee's eligibility will be made by the Foundation.

#### **ELIGIBLE CONTRIBUTIONS**

Only gifts which support the primary educational objectives of approved donees, will be matched.

Gifts must be charitable contributions, which are deductible for federal income tax purpose. If the donor, any member of the donor's family or any individual designated by the donor has received or will receive a benefit or gift as a result of the donor's contribution or the Foundation's matching of such contribution, the donor's gift will not constitute an eligible contribution for purposes of this Program and will not be matched. In addition, matching contributions may not be used to satisfy a pledge by the Company or its employees.

Gifts must be paid, not merely pledged, directly to an approved institution and must be in cash, check, or in marketable securities. The value of the securities, for the purpose of the Program, will be determined by the Foundation and will be quoted market value on the date of the gift or on the last preceding day when such a sale was made.

The *minimum* eligible contribution will be \$250.00. The *maximum* amount contributed by an individual within the twelve months ending June 30, 2007 and eligible to be matched is \$2,500.00.

### **INELIGIBLE CONTRIBUTIONS**

The Company will not match:

Spouses gifts

**Bequests** 

Payments for tuition, books, or other student fees

Gifts intended to fulfill a person's pledges, tithes, or other church or synagogue related financial commitments

Gifts to professors or educators

Gifts given through a third party or gifts given to a donee as a way of supporting a third party organization (i.e. athletic, religious, or social organization)

Other such payments not made directly to eligible institutions even though such payments produce ultimate financial benefit for the institution.

Any gift which does not meet the requirements of an eligible contribution which are set forth under "Eligible Contributions".

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE CONDITIONS**

The interpretation, application and administration of the provisions of the Program shall be determined by the Foundation. Its decision whether or not match any contribution, for whatever reason, shall be final.

The Foundation may suspend, revoke or terminate the Program at any time with respect to contributions thereafter made. No individual and no eligible institution or fund will acquire any rights against the Foundation by reason of the Foundation's failure to make a matching contribution, the suspension, change, revocation or termination of the Program, or otherwise.

Additionally, if a contribution matched by the Foundation is at any time determined to have been an eligible contribution, the Foundation reserves the right to audit institutional record and documents pertaining to the Program and to request supporting donor documentation to the extent it deems such be necessary.

## **HOW IT OPERATES**

The attached form will be used for gifts made between July 1, 2006 and June 30, 2007.

The donor should complete Section A of the form and return the entire form, with his or her contribution to the institution. By signing in the space provided at the end of Section A, the donor certifies that such gift complies with the provisions of the Program as set forth herewith, and authorizes the recipient institution to report such gift for a Warburg Pincus Foundation Matching Gift.

An authorized officer of the institution should complete and sign Section B of the form, certifying that the contribution has been received and that to his/her knowledge, the gift complies with the provisions of the Program as set forth above. Thereafter, the form and a copy of the institution's 501(c) IRS Ruling should be sent to The Warburg Pincus Foundation, attn.: Timothy J. Curt (prior to June 30, 2007).

The Foundation will review the form and authorize payment of matching contributions. Checks will be made payable to and mailed directly to approved institutions.

The Foundation will notify the donor when the matching contribution has been forwarded to the recipient institution.
