# **Clorox Employee Higher Education Matching Gifts Program Guidelines**

The Clorox Company Foundation supports a matching gifts program that gives eligible donors the opportunity to increase the amount of support given to their favorite college or university. An eligible donor may make a contribution to an accredited college or university and request The Clorox Company Foundation to make a matching donation up to \$5,000 a fiscal year. Generally, if the donor's contribution adheres to the Higher Education Matching Gifts Program's guidelines the gift will be matched. However, The Clorox Company Foundation does reserve the right to approve or not approve any request.

## **Donor Eligibility:**

- Full-time, North American employees of The Clorox Company and subsidiaries who have completed one (1) continuous year of service
- Retired employees and current/retired Clorox Company directors

#### **Institutions Eligible:**

- Any two-year or four-year college, university, and graduate or professional school located in the United States, which has regional or professional accreditation.
- Any Alumni fund or foundation which is certified by the chief administrative office of the institution with which it is connected as 1) an integral part of the institution or 2) one which will transmit all contributions directly and undiminished to the institution or 3) one which will use all contributions for the institution's direct benefit.
- The recipient instruction must be located in the United States and be tax exempt with a Section 501(c)(3) in its own name or be an instrumentally of a state or local government as provided by Section 170(c)(1) of the Code. The recipient institution must be recognized by the IRS as a charitable deduction for income tax purposes.

#### **Institutions Not Eligible:**

- Athletics and/or athletic scholarships
- Non-accredited colleges or universities

## Gifts to be matched:

- Donor's gifts will be matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis, subject to the following limitations:
  - Gifts must be \$100 or more.
  - The maximum amount to be matched is \$5,000 annually per Clorox Employee /Retiree per fiscal year.
  - The contribution must be paid in full, not pledged.
- More than one gift can be made to an eligible institution during a fiscal year. Forms must be submitted by October 1 and/or March 1.
- Gifts may be made in cash, check, or in securities that have a quoted market value.

#### **Ineligible for Matching:**

- Unpaid pledges (only paid contributions will be matched)
- Pledges made through the Clorox G.I.F.T campaign
- Gifts made under wills or bequests
- Gifts made in lieu of tuition or payment of service
- Dues paid to alumni(ae) groups
- Subscription fees for publications
- Tickets or payment for benefit functions
- Insurance premiums
- Any other payments that are not direct gifts to an institution, e.g., payments for auction merchandise
- Other in-kind gifts (property, equipment, etc.)
