How does the online process work?

Requests submitted electronically at <u>www.easymatch.com/mcafee</u> will be reviewed and a confirmation em be sent within 24 hours of the request. Once the submission is made, our vendor will contact your organizatio verify the gift has been received. You will be receiving an email if the match request is approved or denied. M funds are issued on a quarterly basis. You can manage your giving history by selecting the "Giving History" lir review the status of your match request.

What is a 501(c)(3)?

A 501(c)(3) is a section of the Federal Tax Code, which establishes the criteria for tax-exempt charitable organizations. An organization must have 501(c)(3) status (be tax exempt) in order to receive matching fund that not all 501(c)(3) organizations qualify for the program.

When is my request matched?

McAfee matches approved gifts on a quarterly basis. Typically, recipient organizations receive the matching dowithin the first six weeks after the completion of a quarter. McAfee matches on a quarterly basis because it is cost-effective to approve and pay these requests in batches. Many of the recipient organizations receive dona from several donors within the same period of time. Making one contribution to the recipient organization for several requests helps both McAfee and the recipient organization reduce overall program administrative expective to request the portion of our budget allocated to matching gifts dire supporting philanthropic activities.

Why isn't a donation to a "Charitable Gift Fund" eligible?

The McAfee Matching Gift Program only matches charitable donations made directly from an eligible donor's p funds directly to an eligible recipient organization. A donation to a Charitable Gift Fund is not a donation to an organization because a Charitable Gift Fund is not an accredited institution.

How is the annual donor limit determined?

The annual donor limit is determined by the actual date of your gift to the recipient organization. For example make a donation of \$1,000 on Dec 31, 2006 to an eligible institution, and you submit your matching gift requirement them in January 2007, the matching gift award (if approved) will be "charged" to your 2006 limit.

Why do I have to submit separate requests for each gift made over a period of time to the same institution?

This provides for consistent records among the donor, recipient institution and McAfee, as well as complies wi auditing standards. By requiring a form for every gift made, McAfee can ensure that every gift is matched appropriately. McAfee considers each gift a separate transaction and therefore must have appropriate docume

Why is it necessary to provide the exact date of my gift?

McAfee requires the exact date of gift in order to determine if the gift is eligible to be matched. Our policy is n match gifts that are more than a year old.

Why does a school need to be accredited?

Accreditation is required because it is an equitable and cost effective way for us to ensure that the recipient so meet and maintain a certain standard of quality.
